In addition to virtual and on-site programming, we have 12 offices across Vermont, at UVM, and in Bennington, Berlin, Brattleboro, Middlebury, Morrisville, Newport, Rutland, South Burlington, Springfield, St. Albans and St. Johnsbury.



How We're Funded

In FY22, UVM Extension's funding came from federal (\$2,372,258) and state (\$5,881,749) appropriations, grants and contracts (\$14,941,870), sales and fees (\$444,415), and gifts and endowments (\$421,996).

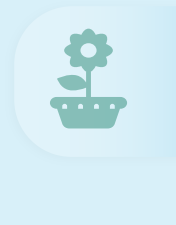

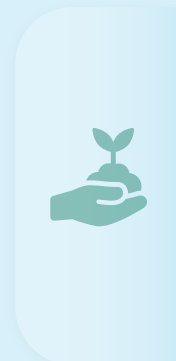
