Where should I go for printing flyers, posters, promotional items, banners?

UVM Print and Mail

Directly go to Waterman Building or Terri Nolan (Terri.Nolin@uvm.edu) to order with your chart string. This will be little more expensive but if you are running out of time, it's the best option.

U-printing (https://www.uprinting.com/)

GSS has a non-profit deal with U-printing, so it will be economical (it will not show you the subsidized rate) but if you must place the order at least **5-10 business days earlier** to avoid enormous shipping.

Once you finalize your order, send the GSS treasurer with all the details with a PDF.
