

## **COMMUTER REQUEST** (This form must be notarized to be valid.)

The University of Vermont considers the on-campus living experience an integral and necessary part of the total education of its students. For that reason, all first-time, first year students are required to live on campus for four matriculated semesters and new transfer students under the age of twenty the first day of classes are required to live on campus for two matriculated semesters. Exceptions will be considered for students residing at home with their parent(s)/guardian(s) within a distance that is determined to be commutable. Requests for exceptions to this requirement must be made in writing to the Department of Residential Life by August 1 for the fall semester and January 1 for the spring semester. A notarized statement from the parent(s)/guardian(s) is required for each academic year that a student is required to live on campus. Students should not make arrangements for alternate housing until they are notified by the Department of Residential Life that an exception has been granted. If an exception is not granted, the student will be held responsible for the full term of their Housing and Meal Plan Contract and any remaining on-campus requirement.
