1. To accept liability and make payment for all reasonable and necessary costs and expenses of health and medical treatment and care, including but not limited to doctors’ and nurses’ fees, medicines, laboratory and x-ray costs, hospital and clinic expenses, and special medical attention costs, provided to said applicant prior to, during, and subsequent to his/her participation in the Program.
2. To release and forever discharge UVM Chinese Language Program, its affiliated institution the University of Vermont, and its host institutions and assigns in China of all claims, demands, damages, actions or causes of action on account of all reasonable and necessary costs of medical care as specified above prior to, during and subsequent to his/her participation in the Program.
3. To protect UVM Chinese Language Program, its affiliated institution the University of Vermont, and its host institutions and assigns in China again any claims, demands, damages, actions or causes of action by said minor, or by any other person, or persons, or entities on account of all reasonable and necessary costs of medical care as specified above prior to, during and subsequent to his/her participation in the Program, and to reimburse and make good to said UVM Chinese Language Program, its affiliated institution the University of Vermont, and its host institutions and assigns in China any losses, damages, or costs the may have to pay as the result of any such claims, demands, damages, actions, or causes of action by the said applicant.

A. The tuition will cover all the major expenses listed as follows:

- 1) 8-10 credits for the Summer Program; 24-27 credits for the Summer and Fall Program; 42-44 credits for the Summer, Fall, and Spring Program transferable from Yunnan Normal University
- 2) Textbooks, audio tapes, and some other major supplies needed for the courses
- 3) Computer lab fee
- 4) Visits and trips to places of interest within and in the vicinity of the city of Kunming when there is no need to stay overnight away from campus
- 5) Transportation to and from the airport when coming or leaving Yunnan Normal University

B. The tuition will not cover the following expenses for which you must also plan:

- 1) International Airfare (about \$1,800) from the airport in a major city nearest you in the US to Kunming, China and then from Kunming, China back to your departing airport in the US.
- 2) UVM International Educational Office Service Fee (summer: \$200; summer & fall: \$400)
- 3) Health insurance and immunizations. (Although Yunnan Normal University has a clinic and the medical treatment is relatively inexpensive, all students participating in the Program are required to carry personal health insurance that is valid for medical treatment in China. If you don't have a valid insurance yet, please get one from CIEE. For more information, please check online at <http://www.counciltravel.com/travelinsurance/>.)
- 4) Physical check-up fee and residence card fee when in China (about \$100)
- 5) Entry visa fee (\$80)
- 6) Room: about \$9 a day for a single room or \$4.5 for a double room. You must find your own roommate; otherwise, you need to pay for the single room rate.
- 7) Meals on campus at Yunnan Normal University (summer: about \$170; summer & fall about \$570)
- 8) Incidentals: laundry, telephone, postage, personal items, gifts, entertainment (about \$20 a week depending on personal preferences)
- 9) An eight-day study tour in China led by a UVM faculty member before arriving at Kunming (\$1,100)
- 10) Tours during vacation periods may cost about \$800, depending on how many places you will go to and how long your trip will be.
