TRAVEL INFORMATION

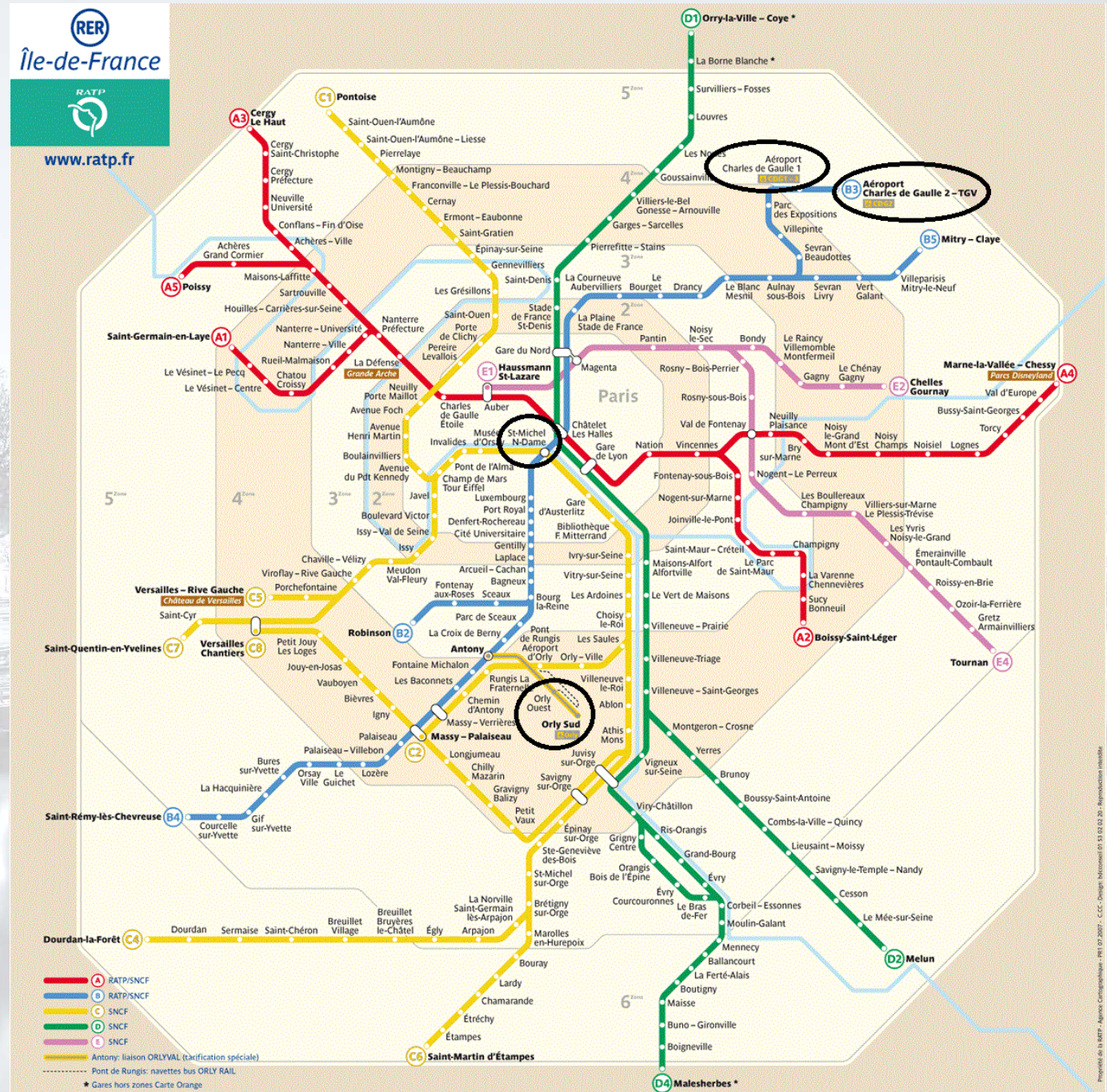
From Charles de Gaulle airport

- Option 1: RER B (see map), travel time until city center (e.g. St-Michel Notre-Dame) = 40 min, cost ~ 10 euros per trip
- Option 2: Air France buses, cost ~ 15 euros per trip (<http://www.lescarsairfrance.com/en/roissy-cdg-shuttle-bus.html>)
- Option 3: taxi, cost ~ 50 to 70 euros

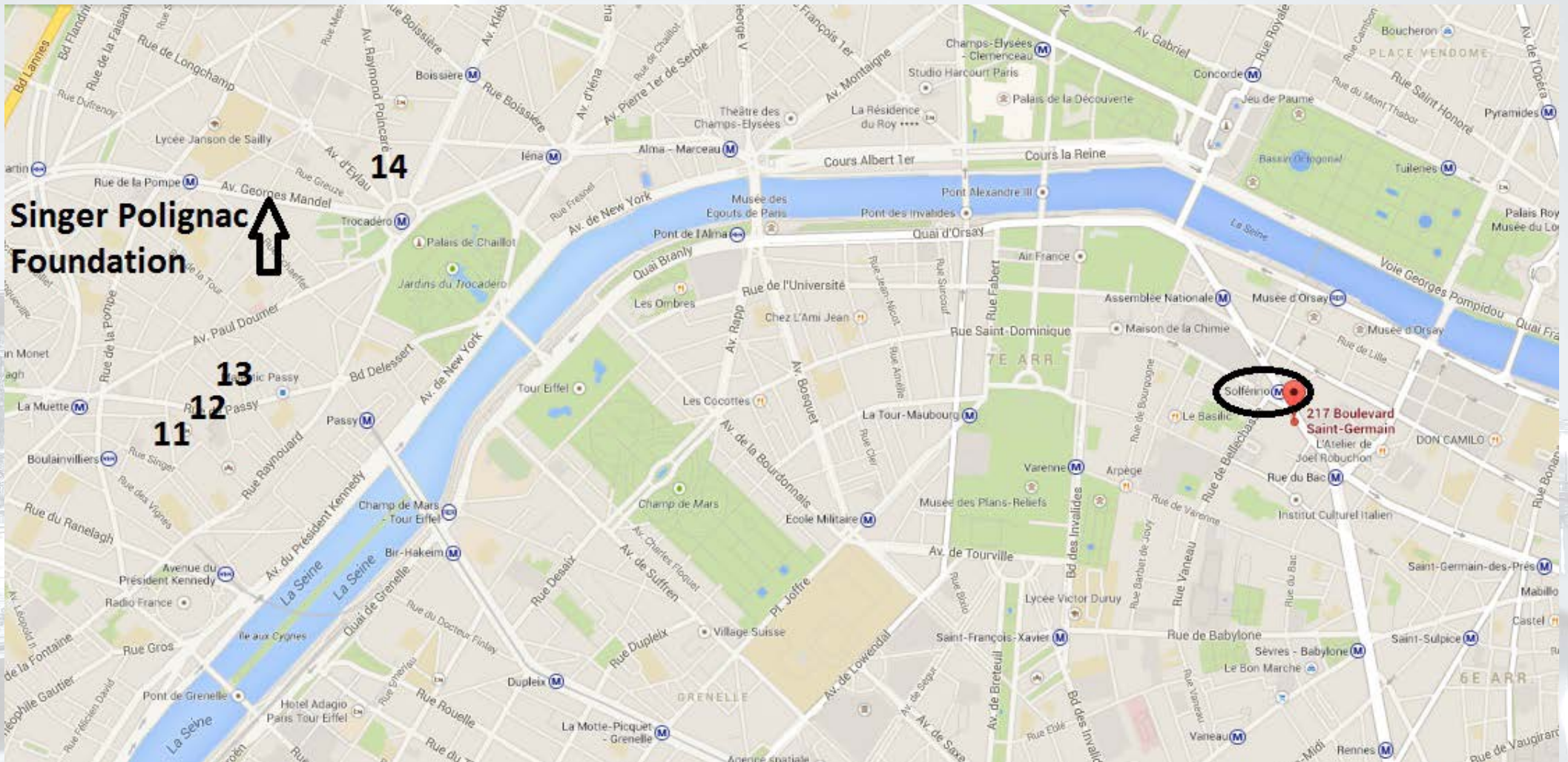
From Orly airport

- Option 1: Metro line Orv (navette OrlyVal) from Orly to Antony and then RER B from Antony to St-Michel Notre-Dame = 46 min, cost ~ 11 euros per trip
- Option 2: Air France Buses, cost ~12 euros per trip (<http://www.lescarsairfrance.com/en/orly-shuttle-bus.html>)
- Option 3: taxi, cost ~ 40 to 60 euros
