**Award Winning Author, Global Thinker,
Environmentalist, and Climate Activist**

Amitav Ghosh was born in Calcutta and grew up in India, Bangladesh, and Sri Lanka. He studied in Delhi, Oxford, and Alexandria and is the author of *The Circle of Reason*, *The Shadow Lines*, *In An Antique Land*, *Dancing in Cambodia*, *The Calcutta Chromosome*, *The Glass Palace*, *The Hungry Tide*, and *The Ibis Trilogy*, consisting of *Sea of Poppies*, *River of Smoke*, and *Flood of Fire*. *The Great Derangement; Climate Change and the Unthinkable*, a work of non-fiction, appeared in 2016. *Gun Island*, was released in September 2019. Ghosh's first-ever book in verse, *Jungle Nama: A Story of the Sundarban*, was published in February 2021. His latest book, *The Nutmeg's Curse: Parables for a Planet in Crisis*, was released in October 2021.
