EIGHT POINTS OF FIELD INSTRUCTION

Each year at the Orientation for New Field Instructors we use these points to walk through the overall responsibilities of field instruction. Please see this is a quick reference to the all the other documentation we have.

- 1. Embrace your identity as a Field Instructor
- 2. Orient student to the profession of Social Work
- 3. Orient student to your agency or organization and the work of that agency or organization
- 4. Teach student how to use supervision
- 5. Assign thoughtful and contemplative work

- 7. Use your Liaisons
- 8. Connect the work to the classroom and the Department Philosophy
