Entry fee is \$2.50 per animal. Make checks payable to Addison County 4-H Foundation. Mail to Martha Seifert, 23 Pond Lane, Suite 300, Middlebury, VT 05753 by Monday, July 1, 2024. Entry fees will not be refunded.

Rules and Regulations

- All health papers (CVI) and approval/lease forms must accompany the animal.
- Animals must have either an AIN (840 tag) or NUES tag.
- All cattle must have had a rabies vaccine at least 30 days prior to the show and shipping fever 2 weeks prior.
- You must provide your own feed and bedding.
- The show is open to all Vermont 4-H members ages 8–18.
- Close- toe footwear is required when working around the animals.
- Your stalling area must be cleaned and checked before you leave.
- All members are responsible for their own animals.
- You will need to bring forks, wheelbarrows, shovels, fans, and other equipment.
- Camper fee of \$40.00 per night must accompany the entry form. Make out a separate camping fee check to ACFFD. Sleeping in the barn is not allowed.
- If you have a milking cow you must bring your own equipment as the parlor will not be open.
