




State 4-H Dairy Show

Registration, Event Details, & Schedule

Participants must register themselves and their animal(s) online by Friday, August 2 at https://go.uvm.edu/2024statedairyshow. The State 4-H Dairy Show is open to all 4-H members ages 11 to 18 as of January 1, 2024.



Important: All members may only bring two animals to the state show. Only one may be a milking cow and the other one may be a dry cow. If you are bringing a cow, you must bring your own milking equipment as the parlor will not be available.

10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Animals Arrive

Papers will be checked by a veterinarian and/or a 4-H dairy committee official at unloading. Health papers, lease/loan, and approval for your animal(s) must be available at this time. **Do not unload your animal(s) until papers have been checked.** For the afternoon, rest your

cattle, relax or bring lawn games to play.

5:30 p.m. BBQ sponsored by Addison 4-H and area businesses. BBQ fee is \$5.00 per person. Please

register by August 2 so we have a complete count for the BBQ.

who are interested in ESE. (There will be a Zoom meeting scheduled later in August to go over

ESE in more detail.)

10:00 p.m. Lights out, in bed and quiet!

9:00 a.m. Judges meet with participants then Fitting and Show classes start first followed by

Conformation classes. We will start with the oldest seniors in one ring and the oldest juniors in the other ring. Show will end after all participants have completed Fitting and Show, and

Conformation classes.
