Some Recommended Pathways to Advanced CAS Core Courses in Health and Society at UVM

- Anthropology: Medical Anthropology/Biological Anthropology/Global Health
 - Medical Anthro and Global Health: ANTH 1190/HSOC 1700 → ANTH 2170 +/or ANTH 2181 +/or ANTH 2191 → ANTH 3192.
 - Biological Anthropology and Human Biodiversity: ANTH 1190/HSOC 1700 and ANTH 1400 → ANTH 2205 +/or ANTH 2410 → ANTH 3475.

• Economics: Health Economics

Health Economics: SOC 1300/HSOC 1600 and ECON 1450 and STAT 1410 and MATH 1212 → ECON 2450 (Option: + ECON 2850) → ECON 3850 or ECON 4850.

Political Science: Health Policy and Politics

• Health Policy and Politics: SOC 1300/HSOC 1600 and [POLS 1013 or POLS 1300] → 3 hours in POLS at 2000 level especially POLS 2301 → POLS 3490 (option: + POLS 4310).

Psychology: Health Psychology

• Health Psychology: SOC 1300/HSOC 1600 and PSYS 1400 → PSYS 2500 → PSYS 3510.

Sociology: Sociology of Health and Illness

- Sociology of Health and Health Care, Population Health, and Intersectional Health: SOC 1300/HSOC 1600 and SOC 1500 → [SOC 2260 or SOC 2300] and [SOC 2500 or SOC 2550] → SOC 3300.
- Sociology of Gender, Reproduction, Health, and Medicine: SOC 1300/HSOC 1600 and SOC 1500 → [SOC 2320 or SOC 2335] and [SOC 2500 or SOC 2550] → SOC 3335.
