Open Enrollment 2025

Open Enrollment for 2025 benefits is now open and ends on November 27 (ending at 11:59pm, EST). This is the annual period of time when benefits-eligible employees, retirees, and survivors can make changes to their benefits. Changes and new rates go into effect January 1, 2025. Highlights for 2025 include:

- 19.3% increase to UVM's longstanding medical insurance coverage Vermont Open Access (PPO 1).
- No rate changes for Dental, Voluntary Vision, Short-Term and Long-Term
- Disability, and Life Insurances. A change from passive open enrollment (benefits roll over year to year without employee action) to an ACTIVE Open Enrollment (employees must take action to maintain benefits for the next calendar year).
