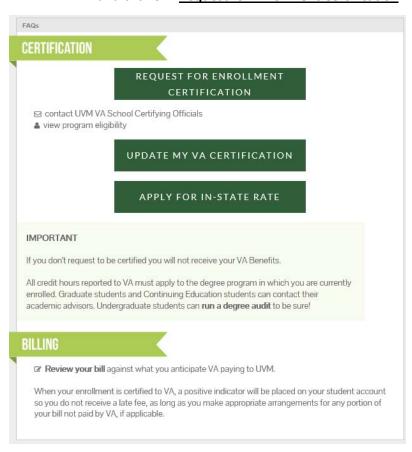


Student Veteran Services

Dear students,

For any term in which you plan to use VA Education Benefits, you must submit a Request for Enrollment Certification through the myUVM Portal. This allows us to send your confidential enrollment to VA so they can adjudicate your claim for benefits.

To request your enrollment certification log in to the myUVM Portal, navigate to the "Veterans" page and click on "Request for Enrollment Certification"

Immediately after your submission you will receive an email confirmation from UVM with the information from the form you submitted.

You will receive a notice from VA-ONCE@vba.gov "Confirmation – Enrollment Information Sent to VA" when your enrollment information has been successfully received by VA.

Online courses, and in some cases Independent Study or Hybrid courses are considered as distance credit hours by VA.

All credit hours reported to VA must apply to the degree program in which you are currently enrolled. Graduate students and Continuing Education students can contact their academic advisors. Undergraduate students can run a degree audit to be sure.

Always review your bill against what you anticipate VA paying to UVM, as applicable.

When your enrollment is certified to VA, a positive indicator will be placed on your student account so you do not receive a late fee, as long as you make appropriate arrangements for any portion of your bill not paid by VA, if applicable.
