The description should include an introduction to the project and its importance, your hypothesis, your planned project, short descriptions of the relevant techniques to be used, potential outcomes, and plan for evaluation by the research advisor.

#### **Obligations That Will Come with Funding:**

- Students are expected to spend the equivalent of 10 weeks of full time research in summer 2003, beginning June 2003.
- Students are expected to attend Career Day April 16, 2003 at the University of Vermont.
- Students are expected to present their work in posters or presentations at Career Day, 2004; faculty research advisors are expected to attend.
- Students are expected to participate in the mentoring program.
- All funds must be expended by Sept. 29, 2003.
- Faculty Research Advisors must agree to respond to questionnaires for longitudinal studies of the students who receive internship awards.
