STUDENT SUMMER RESEARCH INTERNSHIPS AVAILABLE

This is an invitation for proposals for **Summer 2003 Undergraduate_Research Internships**, part of a three year grant awarded by the Biomedical Research Infrastructure Network Program (BRIN), creating the Vermont Genetics Network (VGN). **The due date for applications is February 14, 2003 by 4:00 p.m.**

The Vermont Genetics Network (VGN) is a collaboration among the University of Vermont and other Vermont baccalaureate schools focusing on the broad area of genetics. All areas of science, mathematics, and computer science research are appropriate. Two different internship programs are available. Each internship program will provide a \$3,500 stipend to a qualified student.

Internship Options

- 1) Open to students at Castleton State College, Johnson State College, Norwich University, Middlebury College and St. Michael's College: Work at your home institution with a faculty research advisor during Summer, 2003. A \$3,500 stipend will be provided for 10 weeks of full time research. Up to \$1,000 will be provided for supplies.
- 2) Open to undergraduates at all Vermont baccalaureate institutions: Work at UVM with a faculty research advisor. A \$3,500 stipend will be provided for 10 weeks of full time research. Up to \$1,000 will be provided for supplies.

- Students will be expected to attend Career Day April 16, 2003 at the University of Vermont. This will be an evening event.
- Students will be expected to present their work in posters or presentations at Career Day, 2004.
- Students will be expected to participate in the mentoring program.
- All funds must be expended by Sept. 29, 2003.
- Faculty research advisors must agree to respond to questionnaires for longitudinal studies of the students who receive internship awards.
